By Bus

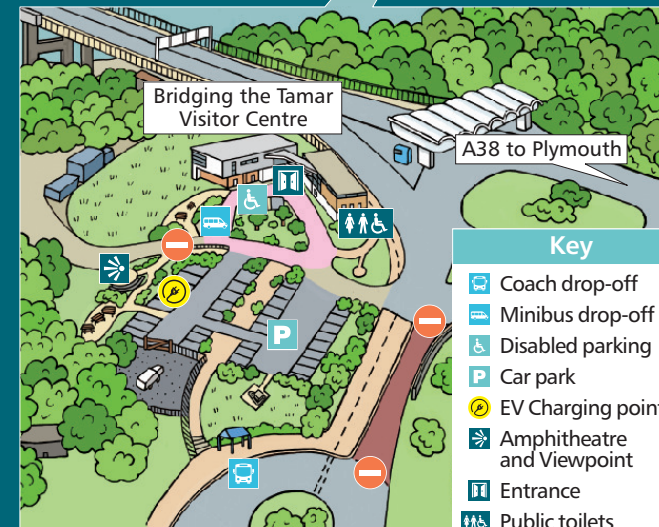
You can reach the centre easily by using the Citybus route 12/12A and Stagecoach route 2

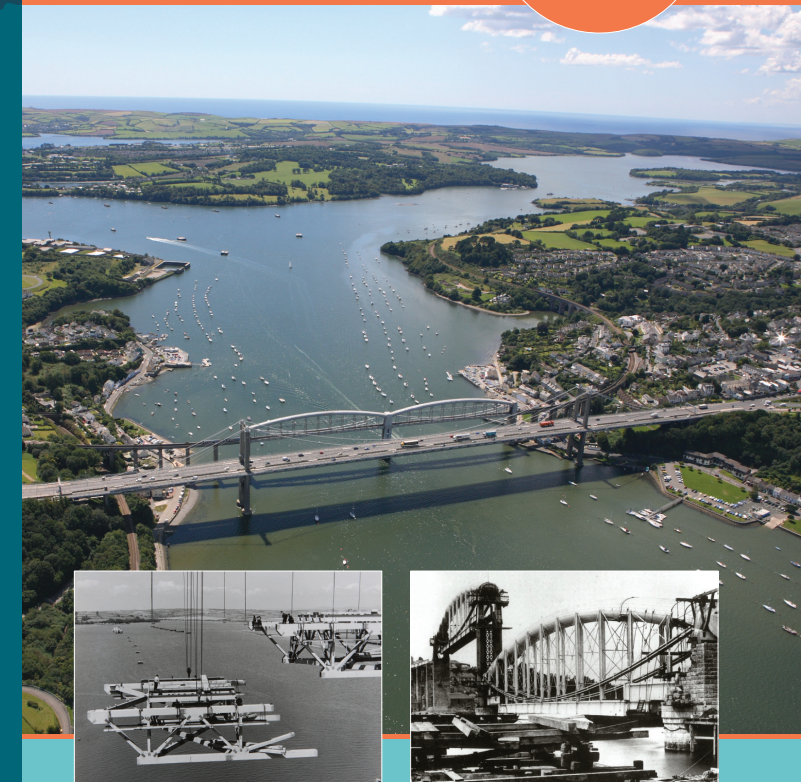

Exhibitions

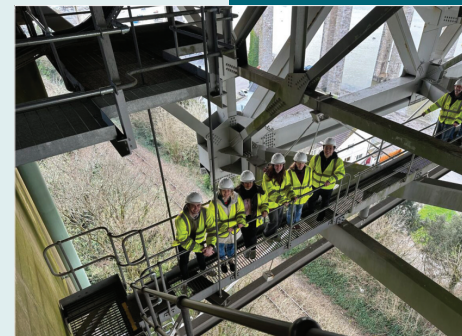
The exhibitions in the Visitor and Learning Centre tell the story of Brunel's Royal Albert Bridge.

- Interactive bridge models and displays.
- Picnic area overlooking the river.

Guided talks

Public guided talks of the bridge run every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Booking is essential, this can be done on our website or by contacting us via email or phone.
